Long-Term Targets

*Kid ASA commits to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 90% by 2045 from a 2020 base year. \* Kid ASA also commits to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions from purchased goods and services, fuel and energy related activities, and upstream transportation and distribution 90% within the same timeframe. \**
